

Thinking Cos - Romaine Lettuce? Think **Terranova** Seeds



Parris Island Cos Romaine Lettuce

- Upright to cylindrical plant habit
- Large, dark green leaves with pale interior
- Forms upright head
- Leaf is slightly savoyed
- Slow to bolt
- Suits Spring, Summer and Autumn conditions



Classical Romaine Lettuce

- Large sized fresh market Romaine
- Sizes easily in the cooler parts of the season
- Very dark green leaf colour
- Very short core length



Cos Lobjoits Romaine

- Attractive cylindrical dark green
- Upright plants with good heading capability



Poco Romaine Lettuce

- Mid sized light green Romaine that weighs well
- High number of leaves
- Leaf length 25 – 30cm
- Extremely good Tip Burn tolerance and low core
- Excellent recovery when processed
- Widely adaptable in most regions



Ranger Romaine Lettuce

- Mid sized dark green leaves
- Leaf length 20 - 25cm
- High number of usable leaves
- Excellent recovery when processed
- Very sweet tasting
- Can be grown in Autumn, Winter and Spring



Symphony

- Large sized, fresh market Romaine
- Used in the warmer parts of the season
- Excellent head weight
- Glossy green leaf colour
- Very short core
- Good Tip Burn tolerance



Viking Specialty Cos Lettuce

- Attractive upright plants
- Good heading capability
- Cool weather production
- Lobjoits type – but quicker maturing
- Corky Root tolerant
- Fresh market or processing
